DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY


This is a Second Amended Director's Report submitted by the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR).

DISCUSSION

On February 26, 2019, IDWR filed a Director's Report for David S. and Margaret E. Pennie's Water Right No. 95-12997 for domestic purposes.

On September 9, 2020, Special Master Booth reviewed water right 95-12997 for issuance of partial decree. In his review, he found an error in the place of use description. The place of use description should be T49N, R06W, S12, NWNE. On September 28, 2020, IDWR filed an Amended Director's Report which contained a typographical error in the Township description in the ADR cover letter for 95-12297. This Second Amended Director's Report corrects the place of use description.

The Director submits for filing with the Court a Second Amended Director's Report for the aforementioned subcase (see attached recommendation).


