## DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY


This is an Amended Director's Report submitted by the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR).

## DISCUSSION

On February 26, 2019, IDWR filed a Director's Report for June and Norman L Jahns' Water Right No. 95-13135 for domestic and stockwater purposes.

On September 10, 2020, Special Master Booth reviewed water right 95-13135 for issuance of partial decree. In his review, he found an error in the condition under the Quantity section. This right included a condition limiting daily diversion volume to 13,000 gallons per day, but that limit is shared with right 95-13136. The Amended Director's Report corrects the quantity condition to limit both 95-13135 and 95-13136 to 13,000 gallons per day.

The Director submits for filing with the Court Amended Director's Reports for the aforementioned subcases (see attached recommendations).
