OTHER PROVISIONS NECESSARY FOR DEFINITION OR ADMINISTRATION OF THIS WATER RIGHT:

To the extent necessary for administration between points of diversion for ground water, and between points of diversion for ground water and hydraulically connected surface sources, ground water was first diverted under this right from the Owen F Jacklin Well located in T50N, R05W, S6, SESW.

This right authorizes the diversion of ground water within the Rathdrum Prairie Ground Water Management Area (RPGWMA). Use of under this right shall be subject to the provisions of the RPGWMA management plan approved by the director, including its conservation goals.




ADMINISTRATION OF THE WATER RIGHTS AS MAY BE ULTIMATELY
