On January 3, 2025, the State of Idaho filed a Petition pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1406D for the commencement of a general adjudication inter se of all rights arising under state or federal law to the use of surface and ground water for the Kootenai River basin water system and for the administration of such rights. A hearing on the Petition was set for November 18, 2025.

On October 21, 2025, the United States moved to stay proceedings in this matter due to a lack of federal appropriations funding the Department of Justice. On November 28, 2025, the United States filed an Unopposed Motion to Reset Schedule. The United States proposes that the stay be lifted and the below schedule entered. Counsel for the United States represents he has conferred with counsel for the other parties and that the other parties do not oppose the motion. Therefore, the Court in an exercise of its discretion will grant the motion on the basis it is unopposed.

THEREFORE, BASED ON THE FOREGOING THE FOLLOWING ARE HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The United States' Unopposed Motion to Reset Schedule is hereby granted.
 - 2. The stay previously entered by the Court is hereby lifted.
- 3. Any response in opposition to the State's Petition shall be filed on or before February 13, 2026.

- 4. Any reply in support of the State's Petition shall be filed on or before February 20, 2026.
- 5. The commencement hearing on the State's Petition is set for February 24, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. (Pacific Time) at the Snake River Basin Adjudication Courthouse, 253 3rd Avenue North, Twin Falls, Idaho. This hearing will be conducted using the ZOOM remote hearing application. Instructions for Zoom are attached to this Notice.
